Committee members unable to attend were Mike Travis, Sr. and Kevin Stewart, LBA; Bob Bowers, YABA; Sandra Wince, LWBA.

With new members to the committee, previous matters of business decided on

by the committee were reviewed and amended as needed.

The name of the new association will be the Southeastern Ohio USBC.
