Speaking of bowling awards...

Achievement awards for league bowlers are "rolling" in this season in great numbers! *Kudos* to these league secretaries for a job well done and a reminder to those who have not sent any in yet - *you are required* in your position as league secretary to track and submit awards earned by your league bowlers and submit them within 20 days of the accomplishment.

Prize Lists are to be done and routed through your leagues for approval by the fifth week of bowling.

Bowlers who quit are required to give two (2) weeks notice and pay for those two weeks.

Grover Wins LWBA Officers and Team Captains Tournament!

Linda Grover emerged from a field of 55 women bowlers to win the 24th League Officers and Team Captains Tournament held on Sunday, October 16, at Tiki Lanes. With an entering average of 146, Linda rolled a handicap series of 672 for first place. Renee Curnell, average 140, finished second with a 645 handicap total; Nancy Garrett with a 165 average was right behind Renee with a 642 pin count for third place. Karen Divilbliss, 147 average, shot 634 for fourth place followed by Tressa Imler, 123 average, in fifth with 628. Brandy Shaffer, 153 aver-

age, and Barb Hill, 139 average, tied for a sixth place finish with 618 series. With balls and shoes put away, the ladies gathered in the lounge for sandwiches, snacks and an informal meeting.

Two award winners unable to be at this year's Joint Workshop were honored: *Chris Hofmann, Secretary of the Year for the 2004-05 season* and *Lynn Stout* who achieved the *Most Increase in Average for the 2004-05 season*. Lynn raised her average 29 pins from a 151 to 180!

Outstanding Director of the Year for 2004-05 was Lynn Ridenour who met all the

criteria needed for this distinction.

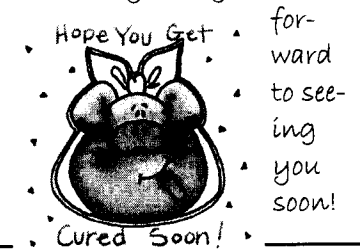
