1. Most recent transcript of work completed in high school or institution of higher learning.
2. Brief statement of ambition and financial need.
3. A copy of the current or previous year's W-2 Form and IRS Tax Return.  
(Parent/Guardian)(IRS Tax Return if High School Student)
4. Outline of high school or college activities. (see page 3 of application form)
5. Scholastic Aptitude Scores. (High School Students Only)
6. Letter of acceptance by an institution of higher learning.
7. Listing of involvement in church and community activities. (Optional for Graduates/Post Graduates)
8. Picture of applicant (wallet size - for publishing in our publications)
9. Two (2) letters of reference. (excluding family members)
10. A \$20.00 money order or cashier's check for processing. (no personal checks)

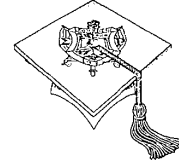
