ABOUT - OURSELVES

During eighties & early nineties of last century, Miyapur was a village with no basic facilities and amenities. Surrounding localities of Miyapur were fast growing like BHEL, Kphb, Madhapur, Bollaram IDA. A Trust was formed in the year 1996 under the name “**POTUKUCHI SOMASUNDARA SOCIAL WELFARE & CHARITABLE TRUST**”, with the intention of improving the living conditions of Miyapur village.

With close coordination with the government and its allied bodies, we could be able to establish once a week farmers market, delivery post office. We have also have our ongoing activities towards health care for students, women and children, health awareness through rallies, tailoring classes for women and interaction with local miyapur school to improve the education facilities of students. Now we have started tutorials for 10th, and Ist year Intermediate students and a two months introductory computer education course for unemployed youth, students & women. For all these activities, we could get support from all the local important personalities in terms of funding and encouragement.

INTRODUCTION

Inspired by achievements and dedication towards social work by late Potukuchi Somasundara Sastry in field of education, a trust was formed in his name to carry on his aims and objectives. He was recipient of National award in education in the year 1991 from late Dr R Venkat Raman, the then President of India and Andhra Pradesh Best Teacher's Award from Late Dr N T Rama Rao, the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh in the year 1985.

Close interaction with Government and its allied local bodies, we could establish successfully the following.

- 1) Once a week farmers' market.
- 2) Delivery Post office.

We have our on going activities in the following areas.

1) Health

- A) Health checkup: Health checkup for women, children and students.
- B) Health awareness: Health awareness programs through rallies.
- C) Medicine Distribution: Distribution of preventive medicines for malaria, chikun gunya, brain fever and dengue.

2) Training Programs

- A) Tailoring class for women.
- B) Training in manufacture of washables: like soap powder, creams and phenol.

3) Computer Education:

Two months' introductory computer course for unemployed youth, students and women.

4) Educational support:

Close interaction with local Miyapur Government School through participation in science exhibition, payment for vidya volunteers, basic toilet facilities.

5) Tutorial Education:

This year (2006) we have taken up teaching for 30, 10th class under privileged students of ZPH School Miyapur and 17, Ist year Intermediate students of local government colleges BHEL & Kukatpally.

ACHIEVEMENTS

I) Established:

- 1) Once a week farmers' market near Miyapur - Bollarm cross roads.
- 2) Delivery Post office near Janapriya Apartments, Miyapur.

II) Health:

- 1) Health check up: About 1000 women and children living in and around Miyapur colonies. Janapriya Apartments, JPN Nagar, Madeenguda, Deeptisree Nagar etc., and 500 students of ZPH School, Miyapur, Hyderabad. had health checkup.
- 2) Distribution of medicines: Whenever viral fevers occurred, 1,00,000 doses for brain fever (from the year 2003) and one lakh doses chicken gunya in the year 2006 were distributed to the people in colonies of Miyapur, Patancheru and to all the government schools in Serilingampally Mandal.
- 3) Health Awareness: Rallies regarding the importance of health and hygiene and preventive care to be taken to avoid viral and congenital diseases were conducted on 2nd sunday of every month with trust students through display of banners and distribution of pamphlets. This year the highlight of the rallies were on AIDS.

III) Training Programs:

- 1) About 1000 women have been trained in tailoring and embroidery.
- 2) About 500 women have been trained in the manufacture of preservative foods viz pickles, jams & jellies and washables namely soap powders, creams, phenol.

IV) Computer Education:

- 1) Unemployed youth, employed youth having small incomes, women and students totaling 400 have been trained in MS Office, DTP & Internet operations. We have given certificates. We are proud to say many have got employment.

V) Educational support:

- 1) In the academic year 2004 – 05 and 2005 – 06, we had close interaction with local ZPH School Miyapur. We made payment for two vidya volunteers, provided 10 nos tube lights, note books, and other study materials.
- 2) In this year 2006 – 07, we have provided approximately Rs 4000/- worth materials for making science exhibits for science exhibition held on 6th November 2006 to ZPH School Miyapur and toilet facilities in the School with support of local philanthropists.
- 3) In the year 2006 – 07, trust students visited botanical garden, BHEL Industrial exhibition and participated in science exhibition.

VI) Tutorial Education:

- 1) In the year 2006 – 07, we have under taken teaching classes in all the academic subjects and spoken English for 30, 10th class students of ZPH School, Miyapur. This we are have done in summer during day time, and in the evenings from 3.30pm to 7.30pm during working days of the school, and during day time in week ends and holidays, There are 20 girls and 10 boys.
- 2) The same activities we have taken up for 17 first year inter students of BHEL & Kukatpally Government junior colleges.

We hope that maximum number of students will pass the public examinations with high percentage of marks.

OUR EFFORTS AND WORK

For all our trust activities, we have a trust center in Littlerock Apartments, (beside Post office) Miyapur.

Established

1) Farmers' market and post office were established through constant approach and perservice with local government authorities.

2)Health checkup:

A) We conducted health camps with the help of qualified doctors.

We wish to record our gratitude to them for their constant help.

B) Distribution of preventive medicine were done through procurement from the government homeopathic hospital, Ramanthapur, Hyderabad.

3)Health Awareness: We have made banners, leaflets with the help of local personalities and rallies with help of trust students. The police were informed of all our activities. Police is a great help to us. Rallies were flagged off by personalities Sri Madhavacari, Assistant commissioner of police, Balanagar, Hyderabad, Sri M Narasingarao, Ex Municipal Chairman, Serilingampally Municipality, Sri M Bikshapati Yadav, Ex Municipal Chairman, Serilingampally Municipality, Mr G D Naidu, AIDS Control Board, Mr Bhadreswar, SHO, Miyapur police Station and Mr Madhusudhan Reddy, SHO, Chandanagar Police Station.

4) Training Programs:

1) We have procured 12 numbers of sewing machines through donations. We have qualified teachers for training.

2) We have procured consumables for manufacturing of washables through funding by local people.

5)Computer Education:

We have 7 numbers of computers. These we got through donations. A teacher is employed for this purpose.

6)Educational Support:

We could mobilize sufficient funds for procuring materials for science exhibition, payment to vidya volunteers and training the trust students for science exhibition and toilet facility at ZPH School, Miyapur.

7)Tutorial Education:

We could mobilize to have a qualified teaching personnel in all the subjects including spoken English. Some of the staff are teaching with social outlook and rest are being paid on honorarium basis. We have taken our trust students to BHEL exhibition, botanical gardens. We have celebrated Trust day in month of June 06, Independence day, Teachers' day, Children's day, New year's day 2007. We are glad to say one philanthropist has donated a pair of dresses to our girl student in the year 2007.

Infrastructure:

We have 3 small rented rooms in our trust center for computer course, 10th class & I st year Intermediate students. We have electricity, drinking water and other basic facilities.

INCOME & EXPENDITURE

1) Income

We have a policy of broad base collection through collection of minimum of Rupees one thousand per year per member because we would like to involve fairly a large group of people whose incomes are affordable and thereby indirectly popularize our activities. 200 persons have committed and 130 members have already been paid. A few persons have given more than Rs 1000/-. Donations are exempted from under 80G of Income Tax Act.

Some donors have given us computers, sewing machines, required furniture, electrical fans and tube lights. Some have supplied us with stationery, notebooks, drinking water facility and the like.

It is gratifying that one person has given a pair of dresses each to 30 girl students.

This year we could collect a total sum of Rs 1,80,000. A list of donors is enclosed in annexure – 1

FUTURE PLANS AND EXPANSION

Having established confidence in ourselves, we wish to extend these activities to more underprivileged persons living in the bordering localities of Rangareddy and Medak Districts.

- 1) To spread health awareness to more localities.
- 2) Health checkups to more number of poor women, children and governments school children.
- 3) To eradicate illiteracy through quality basic education to the poorest of the poor.
- 4) Use of computers has become inescapable necessity to everyone. It is extensively used in industry, commercial establishments, education etc., Therefore we want to train a very many number of the needy poor people in basic computer education.
- 5) To train unemployed women in tailoring to augment their financial incomes of their families.
- 6) To pickup the best talented under privileged students from different government schools and teach them during non-working school hours. Our goal is to train them for higher quality education.
- 7) To train students to achieve good communication skills.

*INFRASTRUCTURE REQUIRED
FOR
EXECUTING FUTURE PLANS*

- 1) The present classrooms for computer and education training are inadequate. We need more floor space area, which is at least two times of the present. There is no scope for expansion in the present location as the space is limited and rented.
- 2) The area likely to be established should be accessible to students, teachers from different localities with easy access to public transport.
- 3) For on going activities *viz* training programs for women, we do not have at present any classroom. We are doing this on adhoc basis through make shift arrangement whenever there are no teaching classes.

REQUIREMENT FOR TRUST CENTER BUILDING

Therefore to fulfill our aims and objectives to more needy people, there is an immediate need for at least one acre of land for carrying out all the activities. Some persons have promised for construction of buildings, once a plot is obtained.

Therefore, we are approaching the competent authorities for land for conducting these social activities.
