surrounding. There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs.

First trial will not start earlier than 11 am.

Move-ups will be permitted between trials. If a title is earned after closing
date, dog may move up providing Trial Secretary is notified by
September 12, 2005.

Placement rosettes for first to fourth in each jump height in each class. All
qualifiers will receive a rosette.

Highest Qualifying Siberian Husky and Great Pyrenees
in each TRIAL will received a trophy..
Highest Qualifying Siberian Husky and Great Pyrenees in each class, both
trials will receive a trophy.
All Qualifying Siberians and Pyrenees will receive a trophy.

Bitches in season CANNOT compete in the Agility test.
All entry fees will be returned to the owner or agent provided that notice in
writing, accompanied with a veterinarian's certificate, is given to the Test
Secretary before the start of the test.
