FEES AS PER Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club fee schedule. All non-regular & unofficial classes \$10, all sweeps \$8.50, and all parades \$10. Make cheques payable to: SHCC - Northern Ontario Chapter. A 10% service fee is added for Visa & MasterCard entries.

CLASSIFICATIONS:

The following classes (divided by sex) will be offered: All regular classes as per the Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Clubs conformation show premium list, **PLUS 12-18 mos** - 12 months but under 18 months on the day of the show.

Veterans Classes - For dogs 7 years of age & over on the day of the show (dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered).

Altered Classes - All dogs over 6 mos of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

All dogs entered in non-regular/unofficial classes must be entered in a regular class in the specialty or in exhibition only. Dogs may be neutered/spayed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Brace/Team - Two /Four dogs shown on a single lead. Ownership all dogs must be identical.

Stud Dog: A dog & at least 2 of his get, ownership need **not** be the same.

Brood Bitch: A bitch & at least 2 of her progeny, ownership need **not** be the same.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Working Dog Classes (WD, WDX) & Sled Dog Classes (SD, SDX, SDU): Both sexes judged together, proof of title to accompany entry. Best Overall and 1st to 4th in each class will be awarded.

SWEEPSTAKE CLASSES - ALL DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN THE SPECIALTY OR IN EXHIBITION ONLY.

Puppy Sweeps - Classes (divided by sex) are 6-9 mos, 9-12 mos, 12-18 mos.

Veteran Sweeps - Classes (divided by sex) are 7 to 10 years & over 10 years.

Sled Dog Sweeps - Dogs must be over 12 mos of age. All males & all females judged in one class. Sled dog titles are not required but proof that the dog has run in harness must accompany the entry i.e. Passport or complete Sled Dog Sweepstakes Specialty Entry Form on the back of the premium list.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES: Best of Breed - The W. B. Screaton Challenge Cup donated by W.B. Screaton, Best Overall Sled Dog Trophy donated by M.P.
