Judging will commence at approximately **12:30 pm** Friday, **9:00 am** Saturday, and **8:00 am** Sunday (EST). However, **if deemed necessary**, a change in starting time may be specified in the Judging Schedule mailed to all exhibitors after entries close.

A dog which has earned its CD title in the US is not eligible for entry in the Novice A class and a dog which has earned its CDX title in the US is not eligible for the Open A Class. Such dogs must be entered in the respective B class. Dogs with an American ILP number are **NOT** eligible for entry at CKC Obedience Trials but, may be eligible for a **PEN** number. Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible for entry at CKC Obedience Trials.

#### LIMITED ENTRY OBEDIENCE

When Judges assignments have reached 7 hours, entries will close automatically, even if official closing date has not arrived. The 7 hours is based on the formula of 9 Pre-Novice entries, 8 Novice entries; 7 Open entries; and 6 Utility entries per hour. (CKC Rule 4.3.3).

When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries may be assigned a position (by class) on the reserve list. The person making the entry shall be notified of his/her position on the list. In the event that the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after closing date, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to, and including, the day of the trial. Entry fees will be refunded within ten days following the trial for those on the reserve list who did not participate in the trial.

#### VETERAN'S CLASS will be offered Saturday, September 17, 2005.

**15.7.1** The Veteran's Class shall be for dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class may be entered in any Regular class.

#### BRACE CLASS will be offered Sunday, September 18, 2005.

**15.5.1** The Brace Class is open to any 2 dogs of any breed and of either sex that has attained not less than a C.D. title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs, nor that they be of the same breed, except when entered in a breed specialty obedience trial.

#### JUNIOR HANDLING - Saturday, September 17, 2005 Judge: TBA (obedience & conformation)

No entry fee will be charged but all dogs handled must be entered in one of the official classes or as Exhibition Only on September 17, 2005.

Junior Novice: ages 7 to 11 (inclusive)  
Junior Open: ages 7 to 11, and have won four 1st places in competition.  
Senior Novice: ages 12 to 17 (inclusive)  
Senior Open: ages 12 to 17, and have won four 1st places in competition.

If a Junior Handler achieves 4 first place wins with competition, he/she must move to the Open Class within his age group.

## ENTRY INFORMATION

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handler and Agents, please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Telephone entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal disruption. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how, or by whom, the errors were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Only dogs, which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close. Any NSF cheques or credit card denials will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge. Entry fee plus service charge must be paid in cash prior to competing.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Show precincts shall be the interior of the CLE show & trial buildings. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules. The Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club and the Trial Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors, and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is not possible to open or to complete the trials, no refund of entry fees will be made. Refunds will be made when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season after entries close, if a Veterinarian's certificate is delivered to the Trial Secretary before the date of the trial. Entry fees will not be refunded should a dog be absent, sick, lame, or excused by a Veterinarian, Judge, or Trial Superintendent. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible. The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the CKC. Dogs MAY be kennelled overnight in the Show Building but not in the Trial Building. It shall be the duty and obligation of the Show/Trial-giving club to see that the judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a Show or Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind.

**EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS AT HOTELS, MOTELS, AND THE SHOW SITE. ANY VIOLATION COULD RESULT IN A SHOW COMMITTEE HEARING AND/OR SUSPENSION OF EXHIBITORS PRIVILEGES.**

## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

**SECTION 20.1** A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

**SECTION 20.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

<b>*Dogs Competing:</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3 to 5</b>	<b>6 to 9</b>	<b>10 to 12</b>	<b>13 or more</b>
<b>Points Allocated:</b>	0	1	2	3	4	5

*\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.*

**SECTION 20.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

**SECTION 20.11** A dog awarded WINNERS, which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

**SECTION 15.1.12c** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

**SECTION 6.3.3. (SECTION 19.7, OBEDIENCE)** of the Dog Show Rules states: A judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at a show or trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

**SECTION 13.6.1** of the Dog Show Rules states: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than 7 days after the official closing. If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

## FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC Registration Number but, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather, enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number.

### TO OBTAIN AN ERN NUMBER:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership (for example, an AKC Registration Certificate) with a written request for an ERN Number.
2. Include with the above, a cheque, money order, or MC/VISA number in the amount of **\$58.85** payable to The Canadian Kennel Club. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN Number to be sent to you.
3. FAXED requests will be accepted. Please include your Visa/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder full name, and signature.
4. This ERN number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as 'Listed' however, failure to apply for an ERN Number within 30 days of the first event WILL result in the cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. Any points or scores earned prior to January 1, 1992 are not subject to cancellation due to lack of an ERN Number. All dogs finished prior to January 1, 1992 must be CKC registered to have a title confirmed.

### PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN):

A performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registerable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Those events are as follows: Obedience Trials, Tracking Tests, Herding Trials, Draft Dog Tests, Agility, Lure Coursing, Earthdog Tests, Hunt Tests, Working Certificate Test, and Pointing Field Dog Tests.

To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met:

1. The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC.
2. The dog, for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration.
3. The dogs must be spayed or neutered.
4. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (not necessary for ILP dogs).
5. The dog cannot be on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List.
6. In the case of a foreign born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC ILP Number.

A dog that is eligible for a PEN **may not be entered as a Listed dog**. Dogs may only enter events after a PEN has been issued to that dog. Cost is **\$53.50**. [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca)
