



## BUTTERFLY CHALLENGE

The 4-ring butterfly is a very popular motif for tatters and everyone has their favorite version of it. How many variations of this basic 4-ring butterfly can you create?

R 30. R 20. R 20. R 30. T&C.



### Rules:

1. You may use:
  - joins - any number and/or placement,
  - picots - any number, length, placement,
  - stitch variations,
  - ring variations,
  - beads - any number, placement
  - any combination of the above
2. The overall stitch count cannot vary by more than +/- 2 ds in each ring as needed to achieve your desired result.
3. All butterflies must be tatted in the same size of thread (your choice of size) so they are the same approximate size.
4. A change in the color of thread and/or beads does not count as a variation.
5. You cannot add rings.



This challenge is just for fun.

It is designed to inspire some creativity and thought.

It is entirely possible that more than one tatter will come up with the same variation(s).

If you have a unique variation that you would like to share with the workshop attendees, we would love to have it.

Bring your butterflies to display at the workshop.
