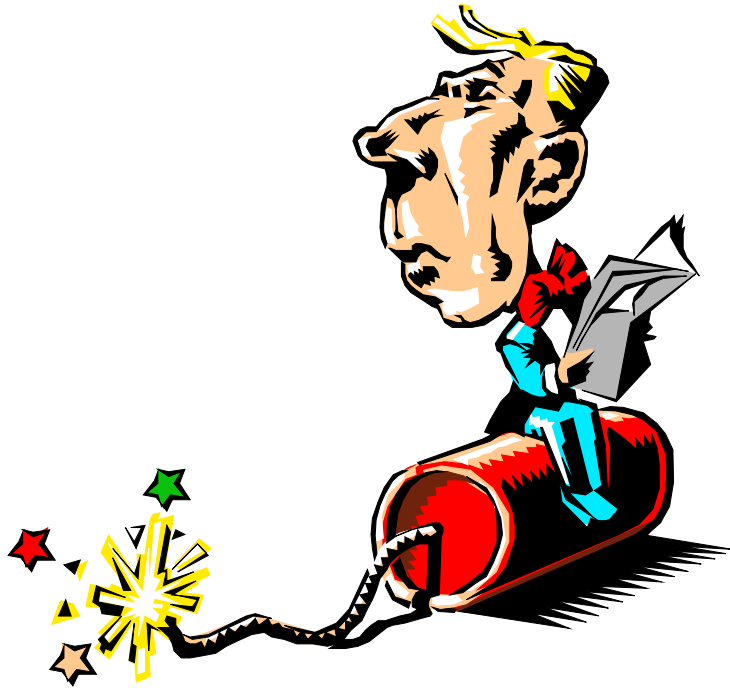
# Rules for Kick-off

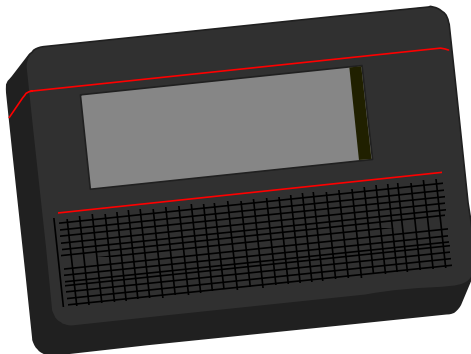
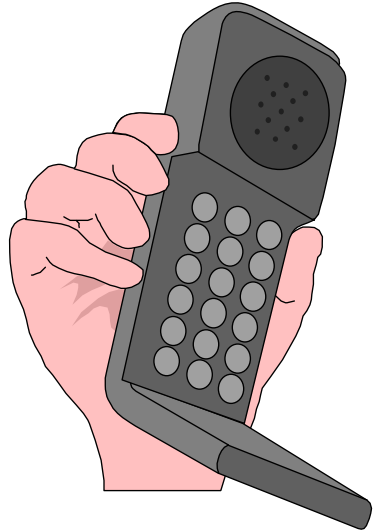
# Rules for Kick-off
