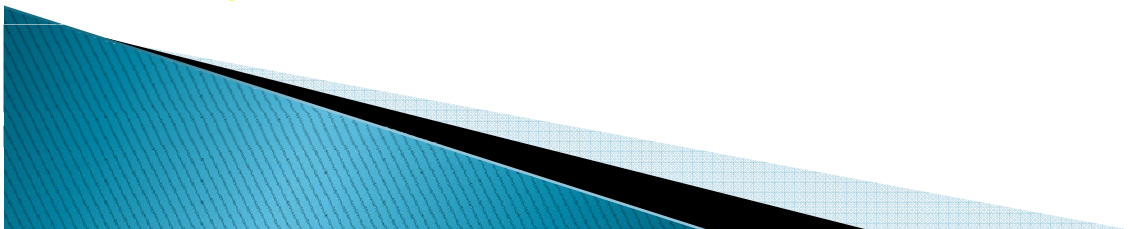

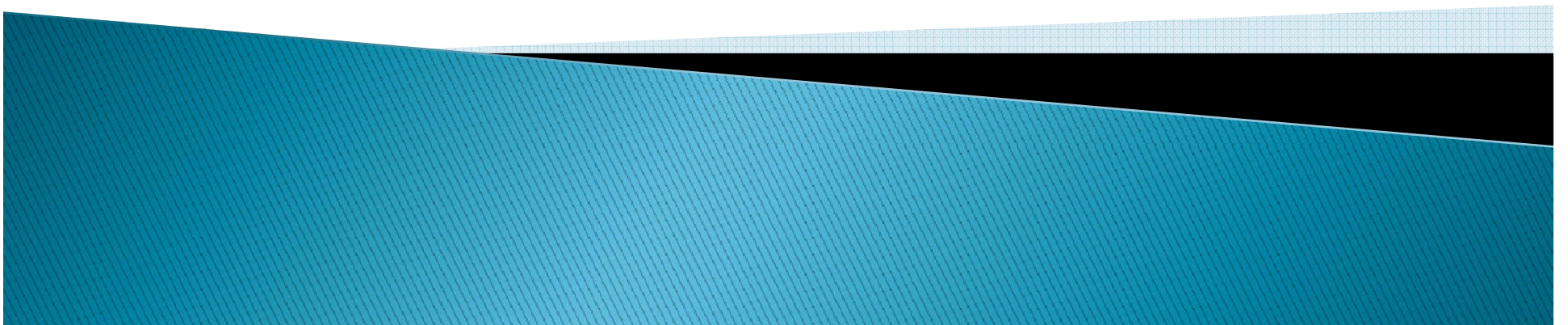

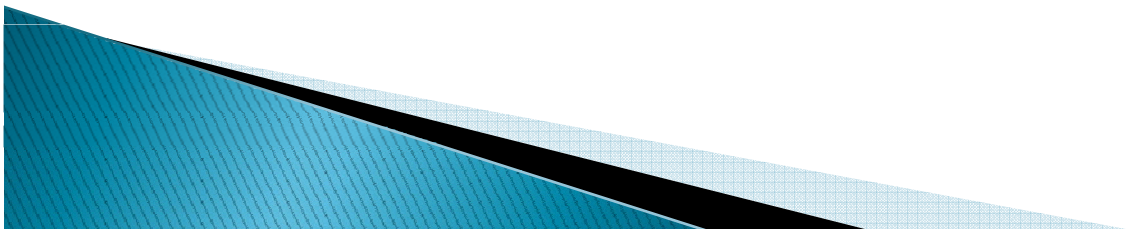
Career Goals
