

OSI 1 – Off-Site Locations, Dates, Times and Directions

- 1.) The two letter of your “**Site Code**” indicate the site name. In the table below find the two letters that correspond to your “**Site Code**” to find your Off-Site Location name.
- 2.) If you do not know your “**Site Code**” go to the **Student Assignments** page for your specific level (1, 2 or 3).
- 3.) To find your assignment, scroll down the page until you find your scheduled Off-Site Location. Look for your complete “Site Code” listing in the table under that location and you will find the specifics concerning your Off-Site assignment (i.e.: the day and date, the time, when you need to arrive by, and the name of the supervisor). After the table you will also find a list of supplies you need to bring for the Off-Site as well as directions to the specific site.

Hospital for Special Surgery

535 East 70th Street (East of York Avenue)
3rd Floor, Radiology
Manhattan

Enter the building and proceed to the elevators straight ahead of you. Go to the 3rd floor. The Radiology Department is to your right. Walk through the reception area and make a slight right turn and follow the hallway of staff photographs to the Radiology Waiting Area. You will meet with the supervisor in the waiting area.

Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:

Subway Take the Uptown E Train from 23rd Street & 8th Avenue to 53rd Street & Lexington. Transfer to the Uptown #6 Train to 68th & Lexington. Exit the station and walk north to 70th Street and then east to First Avenue.

Cross York Avenue and past the entrance to New York Presbyterian Hospital in front of you. Just before you reach a pedestrian overhead you will see the entrance to Hospital for Special Surgery on your left.

NOTE: It is about a 10 to 15 minute walk from the Lexington Avenue subway stop to York Avenue. Please allow ample time for walking this distance. In addition, the elevators at Hospital for Special Surgery are rather slow. So allow yourself extra time for this wait as well.

Supplies you need to bring to this off-site:

- Clean clinic uniform (navy polo shirt, white pants, rubber soled shoes)
- Swedish Institute ID Card
- Pen (blue or black ink only) and Time Piece
- Bottle of drinking water for yourself
- Hand Sanitizer (Like Purell)

Population: We will be working on well patients who are awaiting e-rays, MRIs and ultrasounds as well as staff of the Hospital for Special Surgery.

Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute: Take the C or E train to 42nd Street and switch to the A Train. Get off at 168th Street. You will exit the station at 168th Street and Broadway. Walk two (2) blocks east to Audubon Avenue. Walk uptown (north) to 172nd Street. The Center is between 172nd and 173rd on the west side of the street. Ring bell to enter. Meet with supervisor in the lobby who will take you to the workspace.

NOTE: Enter through Main Entrance and wait for the supervisor in the Lobby Area to the right of the main doors. Once everyone has arrived you will be taken to the work area.

Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:

Subway: Take the Uptown #1 train from 28th Street & 7th Avenue to 42nd Street/Times Square. At 42nd Street change to the #2 or #3 Uptown Express to 96th Street. (You can also take the #1 to 96th Street but the express is faster.) Exit the 96th Street station and transfer to the M96 Crosstown Eastbound bus to Madison Avenue. At Madison Avenue walk north to 1469 Madison Avenue (between 98th and 100th Streets).

You will be working in “The Zone” which is located off the lobby to the right (ask the security guard for directions). Outside the doors to The Zone is a phone. Pick it up and dial 30787 and let them know that you are from the Swedish Institute to do chair massage. You will be working in the Theatre.

Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:

Subway: Take the Uptown #1 train from 28th Street & 7th Avenue to 42nd Street/Times Square. At 42nd Street change to the #2 or #3 Uptown Express to 96th Street. (You can also take the #1 to 96th Street but the express is faster.) Exit the 96th Street station and transfer to the M96 Crosstown Eastbound bus to Madison Avenue. At Madison Avenue walk north to 1184 Madison Avenue (between 98th and 100th Streets).

Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:

From 28th Street & 7th Avenue take the #1 uptown train to 42nd Street/Times Square Station. Transfer to the Shuttle (S) to 42nd Street/Grand Central Station. At Grand Central take the #6 train uptown to 68th Street and Lexington Avenue. After exiting the station, walk north to 73rd Street and then east to First Avenue.

PLEASE NOTE: The walk from the Lexington Avenue subway stop to First Avenue can between 10 to 15 minutes depending upon how fast you walk. Please allow ample time for walking this distance.

Meet in lobby and supervisor will take you to the treatment rooms where you will be working.

Supplies you need to bring to this off-site:

- Clean clinic uniform (navy polo shirt, white pants, rubber soled shoes)
- Swedish Institute ID Card
- Pen (blue or black ink only) and Time Piece
- Hand sanitizer (like Purell)
- Lubricant
- Roll of Paper Towels
- Sheet or Bath Towel
- Bottle of drinking water for yourself
