

## **OSI 3 – Off-Site Locations, Dates, Times and Directions**

- 1.) The two letter of your “**Site Code**” indicate the site name. In the table below find the two letters that correspond to your “**Site Code**” to find your Off-Site Location name.
- 2.) If you do not know your “**Site Code**” go to the **Student Roster Assignments** page for your specific level (1, 2 or 3).
- 3.) To find your assignment, scroll down the page until you find your scheduled Off-Site Location. Look for your complete “**Site Code**” listing in the table under that location and you will find the specifics concerning your Off-Site assignment (i.e.: the day and date, the time, when you need to arrive by, and the name of the supervisor). After the table you will also find a list of supplies you need to bring for the Off-Site as well as directions to the specific site.

**Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:** From 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 28<sup>th</sup> Street, take the 1 Train uptown to 96<sup>th</sup> Street. (You can also transfer to the 2 or 3 Uptown Express Train at 42<sup>nd</sup> Street to 96<sup>th</sup> Street.)

Exit the station at 96<sup>th</sup> Street and take the 96<sup>th</sup> Street Cross-town bus going east. (You catch the eastbound bus on the Southeast corner of 96<sup>th</sup> Street.)

Get off the bus at 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and walk east to 336 East 96<sup>th</sup> Street. Tell the security guard that you are with the Swedish Institute and he will direct you to the area we will be working in.

**Supplies you need to bring to this off-site:**

- Clean clinic uniform (navy polo shirt, white pants, rubber soled shoes)
- Swedish Institute ID Card
- Pen (blue or black ink only) and Time Piece
- Roll of Paper Towels
- Hand sanitizer (like Purell)
- Lubricant
- Bottle of drinking water for yourself

**Population:** We will be working on adults with mental health issues who are stabilized with medication and are living in a self-sufficient residency prior to moving out on their own.

**Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:** On 28<sup>th</sup> Street and Broadway, take the N, R or W Train downtown to 14<sup>th</sup> Street/Union Square. From Union Square, walk east on 16<sup>th</sup> Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. Walk through Stuyvesant Square (cross 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) to Nathan D. Perlman Place. Enter through the Emergency Room entrance which is on 16<sup>th</sup> Street (on your left) between Nathan D. Perlman Place and 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue. At the guard desk turn to your left. Take the elevator to the 9<sup>th</sup> floor. There is a small sign on the wall across from the elevator indicating the hospice. The supervisor will meet you there.

**Supplies you need to bring to this off-site:**

- Clean clinic uniform (navy polo shirt, white pants, rubber soled shoes)
- Swedish Institute ID Card
- Bottle of drinking water for yourself

**Population:** We will be working on hospice patients (terminally ill) and pain management patients. If time permits we will also work on patient's family, caregivers and staff of Beth Israel Medical Center.

**Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:** On Broadway and 28<sup>th</sup> Street, take the R Train downtown to 53<sup>rd</sup> Street in Brooklyn. Ride in the front of the train and you will exit the station on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 53<sup>rd</sup> Street. Upon exiting the subway, walk 2 blocks to 55<sup>th</sup> Street and turn right onto 55<sup>th</sup> Street. Continue walking on 55<sup>th</sup> Street to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. Cross 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and the entrance to Augustana Lutheran Home is in the middle of the block on your right.

**NOTE:** It is about a 8 to 12 minute walk from the 53<sup>rd</sup> Street subway station in Brooklyn to Augustana Lutheran Home so please take that into consideration in planning your travel time to avoid being late.

If you are driving to Lutheran Augustana Center and are parking in their parking ramp, inform the attendant that you are with the Swedish Institute and they will give you a discount on the parking fee.

**Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:**

From the Swedish Institute, walk west on 26<sup>th</sup> Street until you reach Ninth Avenue. Walk one block North (Uptown) to 27<sup>th</sup> Street. You will see a large brick building with 2 entrances numbered 280 and 290. Walk past both entrances and you'll see an entrance with a maroon awning labeled **Penn South Program for Seniors** and enter through the door.

**Supplies you need to bring to this off-site:**

- Clean clinic uniform (navy polo shirt, white pants, rubber soled shoes)
- Swedish Institute ID Card

**Travel instructions from the Swedish Institute:** Take the C or E train from 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street to the 14<sup>th</sup> Street station. Exit the 14<sup>th</sup> Street station and walk north to 15<sup>th</sup> Street. St. Vincent's is located on 15<sup>th</sup> Street between Eighth & Ninth Avenues.

Meet in lobby and supervisor will take you to the treatment rooms where you will be working.

**Supplies you need to bring to this off-site:**

- Clean clinic uniform (navy polo shirt, white pants, rubber soled shoes)
- Swedish Institute ID Card
- Pen (blue or black ink only) and Time Piece
- Hand sanitizer (like Purell)
