EXAMINATION: chest

Examination of the chest shows the heart to be normal in size. The aorta is slightly dilated. Blunting of the left costophrenic sulcus is noted. Apical pleural thickening is noted on the right. Minimal fibrosis is noted in both upper lung fields, more on the right. The finding appears to be inactive Koch's lesion. Comparison with previous study will be of help. Minimal fibrosis is also seen at the left base and could be due to residual change from previous pneumonia.

summary: Examination of the chest shows minimal scar, both upper lung fields, appears to be inactive Koch's lesion. Minimal fibrosis at the left base is also noted.

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
