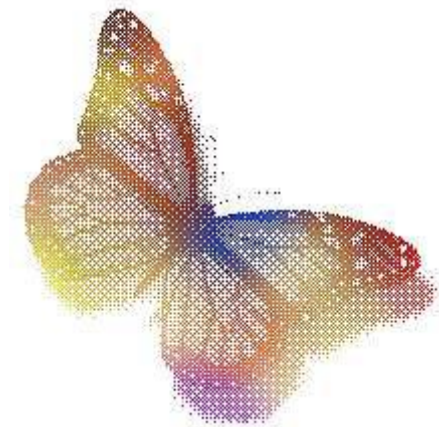


## Dithered Effect in PSP



Here's what we'll be making.

- 8 Delete Selection
- 7 Flood Fill
- 6 Invert Selection
- 5 Select Similar
- 4 New Selection
- 3 Increase Colors to 16 million
- 2 Decrease Colors to 2
- 1 Picture Tube

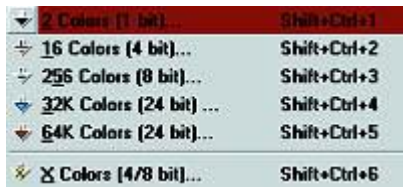
This is the history of steps.



Open a new transparent image. For this example, I used Jasc's tube, Monarch Butterfly.



Go to Colors in your menu. Click on Decrease Color Depth.

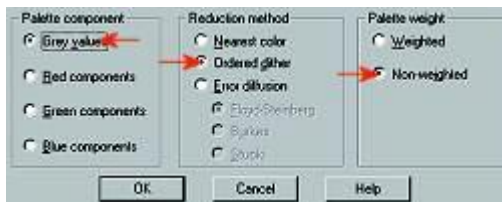


Here are your options.

Click 2 Colors (1 bit).



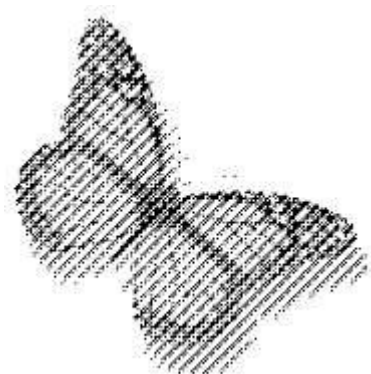
Click 'Yes' when you get this pop-up window.



Click on the indicated (with red arrows) component, method, and palette weight.

Click OK.

You will need to go to Colors, Increase Color Depth, and 16 Million Colors (24 bit).



To make a New Selection, using your magic wand, click any white area on your image.

Go to Selections, Modify, Select Similar.

Now all the white is selected in your image. But we want to select the image itself.

To do that go into Selections, Invert.

Should look like this.



Open a nice colorful image.

Click on the flood-fill tool.

From your color palette, select the your colorfull image from patterns. Flood-fill your image. Took me a couple times of moving my flood-fill tool around to catch it but it can be done.

Delete the Selection (or deselect the marching ants).

Save your image.
