

# AujaqSyl

## TrueType Syllabics Font for Mac & Windows

AujaqSyl is a 7 bit TrueType font designed to work with Macintosh System 7+ keyboard & U.S. English keyboard in MS Windows. AujaqSyl was originally called AujaqMPC. It was renamed & given a new ID number. The old ID number was apparently taken by a popular desktop publishing font which often caused an ID conflict.

There are five (5) dots that can be used to get the dotted symbols. Each of the five dots is positioned differently to allow for correct positioning over a particular symbol. The first two dots are accessible with the Tilde (~) key. The first dot is positioned to the far right so that is best for use with wide symbols like ᳵ, ᳶ ᳷, etc. The second dot is accessed with Shift+Tilde key. This dot is lower and best for use with symbols like ᳸, ᳹, ᳺ, etc. The next dot is in the right parenthesis (]) key. This dot is more to the centre so its ideal to use as the "generic" dot and best with symbols like ᳻, ᳼, ᳽, etc. The last set of dots are in the More Than (>) and Less Than (<) keys. The dot in the Less Than (<) key is further to the left and best for symbols like ᳾, ᳿, ᳺ, etc., and the dot in the More Than (>) sign key is further to the right and best for such symbols as: ᳼, ᳽, ᳾, etc.
