CADET CORPS ACT

(Act 10 of 1929)

AN ACT to authorize the establishment of school cadet corps.

Commencement [13 July 1929]

1. SHORT TITLE

This Act may be cited as the Cadet Corps Act.

2. DEFINITION OF VOLUNTEER FORCE

In this Act the expression “the Volunteer Force” means the Volunteer Force established under the Volunteer Act, 1907

3. FORMATION OF CADET CORPS

The Governor may authorise the formation of boys over twelve year of age who are attending school into school cadet corps, and may authorize such corps or any portion thereof to be attached to the Volunteer Force for the purposes of drill and training.

4. APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS

The Governor General shall appoint the officers of cadet corps with such rank as he or she shall think necessary.

5. REGULATIONS

The Governor General may make regulations governing the formation, organization, and administration of school cadet corps.
