

JessHouse Hold 'em Dice

Your Hands:

Five of a Kind = 50 points + Die Value
 Four of a Kind = 40 points + Die Value
 Full house = 25 Points + Die Value
 Straight = 20 Points + Die Value
 Three of a kind = 10 Points + Die Value
 Two Pairs = Die Value
 One Pair = Die Value
 Highest Die = Die Value

Poker Dice vs. The Mighty D6

Ace = six Jack = three
 King = five Poker 10 = two
 Queen = four Poker 9 = one
 (In case you don't have the poker dice)

Basic Rules:

1. Dealer rolls first five dice
2. Players get to roll two dice each
3. Each player gets 3 rolls to make their value
4. Player rolls combine with the dealer roll to get a good hand
5. Best Hand wins the round
6. Players must take their highest Die value (their two dice + three of the Dealers) as their score if they fail to roll a hand.
7. Dealer can play too, in fact, everyone can deal
8. Five Dice make a hand
9. You'll need this sheet printed, 7 poker dice or D6 type dice (5 dealer, 2 for the player), a pen or pencil.
