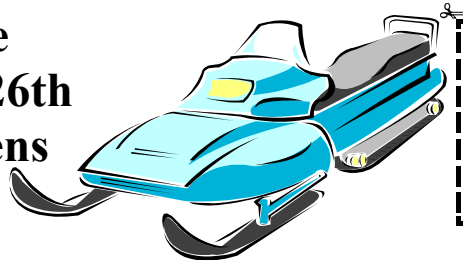

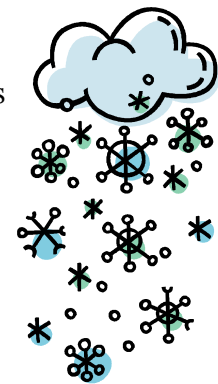

It was also discussed of a need for a bridge on Snyder's land, and the Delaware County Sheriff's office has had complaints of snowmobiles in Earlville, however we do not have any trails leading into the town, so we are in the clear here, Edgewood has also had a few complaints. We ask is that everyone stay on the marked trail and enjoy the snowmobiling season.

Club Activities - We will be holding our second club ride this season on January 26th @ 9 A.M. at E-Z Pickens, we hope everyone can join us. We will also be having radar runs on January 20th and February 10th weather and ice permitting.
