#### How to use the lesson

1. Give each of your students a copy of the worksheet and ask them to fold it so that only the first exercise is showing. Tell them they have five minutes to read the story and find the extra word in ten of the lines. If they are not working very quickly, give them an extra minute.
2. When the time limit is up, stop your students and ask them to check their answers with the person sitting next to them.
3. Check answers in open class.
