dawn noun [count or uncount]

the beginning of the day, when it begins to get light:

We had to get up at the crack of dawn (=very early in the morning).

dress up phrasal verb

to put on clothes that are more formal than the clothes that you usually wear:

Do I have to dress up for dinner?

fireworks noun [plural]

objects that make loud noises and coloured lights in the sky when they explode

memorable adjective

worth remembering, or easy to remember:

a memorable experience

toast verb [transitive]

to drink a toast to someone
