Club members come from a diverse background, but they have in common their passion for flying. A number of club members are airline or private pilots. Others are highly skilled in designing, building and test flying model aircrafts - something that is just not possible with full scale aircraft.

We welcome visitors and new members, including beginners to our hobby. Senior members at the club can provide advice and hands on instruction to beginners. We encourage you to come along and talk to us before purchasing a model and radio gear. Club membership includes insurance cover which is essential if you wish to fly models.

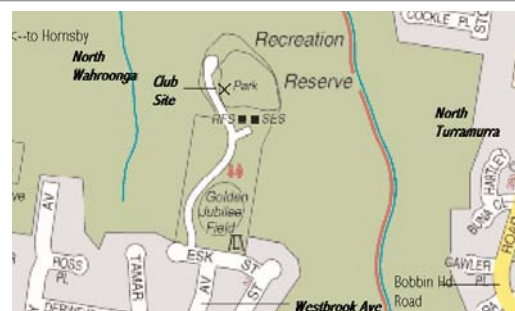

Note we do not permit winch launching, or internal combustion or jet powered models at our site (for noise reasons).

From Burns Road (UBD map 154 F6) turn north into Westbrook Avenue. X on this map marks the spot where we set up at the club. For the nearest shops go to East Wahroonga shops on Hampden Ave (next road Eastbound parallel with Westbrook). Sunday morning is our club session.
