

THE APOCALYPSE OF JOHN

ADAPTED FROM AN UNDERGROUND INTERNET VERSION

Commonly, this is called “The Revelation of John”. “Apocalypse” means the same, with enhanced emphasis.

Apocalypse 1: 1. The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John (A First Century disciple of God, following devotedly the teachings of Jesus of Nazareth, named in Aramaic, Yoshua)...

8. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty. (This represents the fullness of time, all wrapped up in the person of God’s one self.)

19. Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;...

Apocalypse 2: 26. And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations (effects through the world, high and low brought even): 27. And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers (the Apocalypse): even as I received of my Father.

28. And I will give him the morning star (light-bringing “Lucifer” according to Latin of that day brought low).

29. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches. (Omitting the specific messages, these are to keep repenting and doing right things first, to be faithful unto death and eternal life in paradise, to give up abominations right away, particularly to give up the sin of adultery, to be sure watchful at all times, to welcome the repented hypocrites who come unto Christ and to be zealous against your former complacency.)...

Apocalypse 3: 3. Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee...

12. Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God (divine establishment), which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name (Elohim). (Here comes the promise of eternal life in the kingdom of God!)... 20. Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me (the marriage banquet, as in Jesus’ parable)...

Apocalypse 4: 1. After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven (the golden doorway): and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter. (What Apocalypse will be!)

2. And immediately I was in the spirit (light of the Lord illuminating): and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne. (This one represents the unity of God, seen in trinities and duality – all mock schism.)

3. And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone (This lofty person – the one – is double: part greenish, part orange and red; first like jasper, the birthstone of March, and then like the male planet Mars): and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald (the birthstone of May or June).

4. And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold (twenty four days into that month).

5. And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God (the churches, symbolic of views and messages).

6. And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal (vision): and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four beasts (months) full of eyes before and behind (days of the past and future).

7. And the first beast was like a lion (Messiah – January), and the second beast like a calf (past age – February), and the third beast had a face as a man (present), and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle (future – April). (Here we have again the succession of prophecies, leading us along the way of Jesus until the end of the age.)

8. And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him (years are wings like seraphim have in Isaiah 6:2); and they were full of eyes within (they are full of true introspection, which accompanies deep devotion): and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

9. And when those beasts (also representing natural creations such as humans) give glory and honour and thanks to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever, 10. The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever (four months plus twenty-four days), and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, 11. Thou art worthy, O Lord (God’s one self reunified), to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Apocalypse 5: 1. And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book (a history) written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals. 2. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice (very meaningful), Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? 3. And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book (worthy of its understanding), neither to look thereon... 5. And one of the elders (the day of Apocalypse) saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda (meaning the Messiah), the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof. 6. And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb (Christ) as it had been slain (on Golgotha), having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God (all churches) sent forth into all the earth (to other religions too)... 8. And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps (music of the spheres), and golden vials (holy) full of odours ("sweet liquids"), which are the prayers of saints. (The only one worthy, Jesus Christ – peaceful lamb of God's love – receives bows that signify May 24th 2012.) 9. And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; 10. And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth (in the New Jerusalem). 11. And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands (exceeding in number); 12. Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, honour, and glory, and blessing. 13. And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them (Nature ring!), heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever... Apocalypse 6: 1. And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals... 2... behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow (the blow of Christ on humanity); and a crown (leadership) was given unto him: and he went forth... to conquer... 3. And when he had opened the second seal... 4... another horse that was red (the bloody anti-Christ): and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword. 5. And when he had opened the third seal... a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand (fairness Judgment Day)... 7. And when he had opened the fourth seal... a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death... (Hades) followed with him... 9... And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held (all martyrs, dying for Christ): 10. And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth (wailing quite audibly)? 11. And white (pure) robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season (no one hears them at first), until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed... 12. And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake (upheaval); and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair (nuclear winter), and the moon became as blood (like a lunar eclipse, portending death); 13. And the stars of heaven (nuclear missiles) fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind. 14. And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together (which is done after reading the Word); and every mountain and island were moved out of their places (commotion below). 15. And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains (those who can get away to the tunnels there); 16. And said to the mountains and rocks (praying for their own cancellation), Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb (whom formerly they scorned): 17. For the great day of his wrath is come (as they inherently knew it would); and who shall be able to stand (no one)? Apocalypse 7: 1. And after these things I saw four angels (the archangels Michael, Gabriel, Raphael, and Uriel) standing on the four corners of the earth (North, South, East, and West), holding the four winds... that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree. 2. And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, 3. Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads (for rapture).

4. And I heard the number of them which were sealed... an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel (all deep-rooted believers)... 9. After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues (of the generation 1970 to 2012), stood before the throne, and before the Lamb (Christ), clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; 10. And cried with a loud voice... Salvation to our God... upon the throne, and unto the Lamb (our one Messiah). 11. And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, 12.... Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever... 14... These are they which came out of great tribulation (the last days), and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. 15. Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them (Emmanuel). 16. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. 17. For the Lamb (Christ) in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. (In Apocalypse 8 Jesus Christ opens the seventh seal, the lamb of eternal peace. Seven angels stand before God. All sound and there come a third of this and of that being destroyed. Nowhere else in the Bible do so many thirds occur in one space. Hail, fire, and blood kill a third of trees and all grass. A great mountain is cast in the sea so a third of it becomes blood, killing a third of the sea creatures and destroying a third of the ships.) Apocalypse 8: 10... the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters; 11. And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter. (Because the plant wormwood was traditionally used to cause abortions, this represents the bitter taste that fetal abortion has left in America's mouth. Abortion is usually "dilation and extraction" – cutting the baby up and vacuuming it out of the uterus; wormwood represents legalized abortion.) 8: 12. And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise. (Apocalypse 6:14 says the heaven departed, yet in 8:12 a third of the sky is darkened. This is because each of the seven seals represents the entire end of the age, rather than a stage in the process.) 13.... I beheld... an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound! Apocalypse 9: 1. And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit (freedom from tribulation)... 3... there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power (like a plague). 4... it was commanded them that they should... hurt... only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads. 5... not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months (the battle after Apocalypse)... 6. And in those days shall men seek death, and shall not find it (as in Apocalypse 6:16-17)... 7... the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold (representing the rich), and their faces were as the faces of men (operating the machines). 8... And they had hair as the hair of women (the land of equality initiates), and their teeth (communication) were as the teeth of lions (American English). 9. And they had... as it were breastplates of iron (machines); and the sound of their wings (flying) was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle (very noisy)... 13. And I heard a voice... 14... to the sixth angel... Loose the four angels... bound in the great river Euphrates (Bush's axis of evil – Afghanistan, Iraq, Iran, and North Korea, bound up in war on Iraq). 16... the number of the army... were two hundred thousand thousand (2 million – the number in China's army today)... 17. And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth (reddish-orange), and brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions (American technology)... 20. And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols... 21. Neither... their murders, nor... sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor... thefts. (Totally lost souls.)

Apocalypse 10: 1... I saw another mighty angel come down... clothed with a cloud (mushroom)... and a rainbow (the eternal covenant) was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun (bright atomic blast), and his feet as pillars of fire: (return salvo) 2...in his hand a little book open (yesterday): and he set his right foot upon the sea... his left foot on the earth, ("one if by land, two if by sea") 3. And cried... as when a lion roareth (American English)... seven thunders (one for each continent) uttered (great portents)... 4... I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not. 5. And the angel... lifted up his hand to heaven, 6. And swore by him that liveth for ever... (God's one self), who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be time no longer: 7. But in the days... the seventh angel... shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets. 10. And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter. (The small history from 1776 to 2012 looks good at first, but turns out bitter, like the waters turned by Wormwood – 1972 followed by one generation, 40 years.)

Apocalypse 11: 3. And I will give power unto my two witnesses (David and Jesus – of Moses), and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days (3½ years), clothed in sackcloth (sign of deep devoted repentance). 6. These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will. 7. And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them. (Dishonored in death, they return to life after 3½ days.) 12. And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them (having to face eventual justice). 13. And the same hour (concurrently) was there a great earthquake (upheaval), and the tenth part of the city fell (computerized death), and in the earthquake were slain of (Godly) men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted (Diaspora), and gave glory to the God of heaven. 14. The second woe is past; and, behold, the third woe cometh quickly. 15. And the seventh angel sounded (finishing the mystery of God); and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever. (The Divine Right of Kings is from Mary Magdalene's offspring by her husband Jesus. Lately, this has been a much-disputed point, The Da Vinci Code echoing Holy Blood, Holy Grail's SangReal.) 18... the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth (the actual perpetrators of apocalypse).

Apocalypse 12: 1... there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman ("Spirit") clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet (lights of day and night "for signs"), and upon her head a crown of twelve stars (Zodiac): 2. And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered. (This is the fullness of time.) 3. And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon (Satan), having seven heads (the continents) and ten horns (digital communication), and seven crowns upon his heads (worldly leadership). 4. And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth (computer-launched)... 5. And she ("Spirit") brought forth a man child (Messiah), who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron (hard): and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne (honor). 6. And the woman fled into the wilderness (They go back to nature.), where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days (3½ years). 7. And there was war in heaven: Michael (archangel) and his angels fought against the dragon... and his angels, 8. And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. 9... the Devil... Satan, which deceiveth the whole world... was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. 10... the accuser of our brethren is cast down... 11... by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony... 12. Therefore rejoice, ye heavens... Woe to the inhabitants of... earth and... sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time. 13. the dragon... persecuted the woman ("Spirit")... 14. And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle (USA – open territory), that she might fly into the wilderness (nature), into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time (whenever forever), from the face of the serpent (a sanctuary).

15. And the serpent cast out of his mouth water (vomiting the spirit) as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away (literally) of the flood (giving in to the revulsion toward holiness). 16. And the earth helped the woman... and swallowed up the flood... (nullifying this negation of God). 17. And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed (other children of God left here) which keep the commandments of God (submissive believers), and have the testimony of Jesus Christ. Apocalypse 13: 1. And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads (continents) and ten horns (digitized), and upon his horns ten crowns (leaders of globalization), and upon his heads the name of blasphemy (God's enemies). 2. And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard (spotted – globalization), and his feet were as the feet of a bear (Russia and China), and his mouth as the mouth of a lion (American English like the U.N.): and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority (evil). 3. And I saw one of his heads (Australia) as it were wounded to death (the hole in the ozone); and his deadly wound was healed (it closed): and all the world wondered after the beast (thinking creation itself is the answer). 4. And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him? (The masses join in idolizing God's creation.) 5. And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things (portents) and blasphemies (denial of God); and power was given unto him (this system) to continue forty and two months (2½ years). 7. And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. 8. And all that dwell upon the earth (Babylon's drunkards) shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world (Christ Almighty). 11... I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb (some cult leader), and he spake as a dragon. 14. And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast (mind control); saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast (see themselves), which had the wound by a sword, and did live (through them). 17... no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Apocalypse 14: 1. And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion (the rapture), and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name (Elohim) written in their foreheads... 3. And they sung as it were a new song before the throne (glory), and before the four beasts, and the elders that day: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth... 6. And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven (satellite ministry), having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, 7. Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters... 8. And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city (modern civilization), because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication (corruption causing destruction). (The third angel condemns those with the mark of the beast.) 13. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours (R.I.P.); and their works do follow them (heavenly rewards). 14. And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man (Jesus), having on his head a golden crown (kingship), and in his hand a sharp sickle (Russia, returning the atomic exchange). 15. And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe (fullness). 17. And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle (China). 18. And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire (like Prometheus, drawing down fire from heaven, small against big); and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters (families, social groups) of the vine of the earth (humanity); for her grapes are fully ripe. 19. And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God (families dying together). 20. And the winepress was trodden without the city (those fleeing from ground zeroes), and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles (armies), by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs (1600 furlongs, 40 times 40, represents all generations – earth's civilization).

Apocalypse 15: 1. And I saw another sign in heaven... marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues (concurrent); for in them is filled up the wrath of God. 2. And I saw... a sea of glass mingled with fire (fiery vision); and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. 3. And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb (music of the spheres), saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King (Lord) of saints. 4. Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee (coming to know the one true God); for thy judgments are made manifest (God's one law). 5. And after that I looked, and behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened: 6. And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. 7. And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever. 8. And the temple (heaven) was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled. Apocalypse 16: 1. And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth. 2. And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore (radiation sickness) upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image (survivors of atomic exchange). 3. And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea (justice for murder of innocence). 4. And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood (like returns, on earth). 5. And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus. 6. For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to drink... 8. And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire (waves emanating from atomic blasts). 9. And men... blasphemed... and they repented not... 10. And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast (military command centers); and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, 11. And blasphemed... because of their pains and their sores, and repented not... 12. And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates (flowing through Iraq); and the water thereof was dried up (naked), that the way of the kings of the east (Russia and China) might be prepared. 13. And I saw three unclean spirits (USA, Russia, and China) like frogs come out of the mouth(s) of the dragon... the beast, and... the false prophet. 14. For they are the spirits of devils, working (but unholy) miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty. 15. Behold, I come as a thief. (Battle is robbed of its glory.) Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments (the whole armor of God), lest he walk naked, and they see his shame. 16. And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon (in Israel). 17. And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice (God's) out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. 18. And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. 19. And the great city (Jerusalem) was divided into three parts (Jewish, Christian, Muslim), and the cities of the nations fell (in turn): and great Babylon (Iraq) came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his (God's) wrath. 20.... every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. 21... there fell upon men a great hail... Apocalypse 17: 1. And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters (people's spirits): 2. With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication (opposed to Christian sharing). 3. So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast (of a whore), full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads (continents) and ten horns (digitization). 4. And the woman was arrayed in purple (royalty) and scarlet colour (for sale), and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication: 5... upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT (not just Iraq),

THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS (sell-outs) AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH (perversions). 6. And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and... martyrs of Jesus (Joan of Arc et al)... 7... the angel said unto me... I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her... 8. The beast that thou sawest was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world (survivors of the atomic exchange), when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is (to be). 9... The seven heads are seven mountains (continents), on which the woman (seductive greed) sitteth. 10. And there are seven kings: five are fallen (the Americas, Africa, Europe, and Asia), and one is ("still" – Australia), and the other is not yet come (Antarctica); and when he cometh, he must continue a short space (small stride). 11. And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth (king), and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition (is destroyed). 12. And the ten horns receive power as kings (for) one hour with the beast... 14. These shall make war with the Lamb (of God), and the Lamb shall overcome them (peace and love): for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings (Divine Right): and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful. 15... The waters... where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues. 16. And the ten horns... (digitization) upon the beast, these shall hate the whore (betraying her), and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire. 17. For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will (the ghost in the machine)... 18. And the woman... is that great city (greedy establishment), which reigneth over the kings of the earth. Apocalypse 18: 1. And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. 2. And he cried..., saying, Babylon the great is fallen (civilization), and is become the habitation of devils... 3. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication,... and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies... 4. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people (both in rapture and renunciation of greed), that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues. 5. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities... 8. Therefore shall her plagues come in one day (May 24th 2012), death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire (scorched earth): for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her. 9. And the kings of the earth... shall bewail her... when they shall see the smoke of her burning, 10. Standing afar off for the fear of her torment (having fled), saying, Alas... that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come. (Now we are told that all seven seals are opened concurrently and quickly.) 11. And the merchants of the earth shall weep... 17. For in one hour so great riches is come to nought... and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off... 19... for in one hour is she made desolate. 20. Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye holy apostles and prophets; for God hath avenged you on her. 21. And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found no more at all. 22. And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman... shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee; 23. And the light of a candle shall shine no more... in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride (loving-making) shall be heard no more... in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived. 24. And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth (forever responsible for martyrs, and now all humanity's dead). Apocalypse 19: 1... I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: 2. For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand... 4. And the four and twenty elders and... four beasts (months and days) fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia... 7. Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb (reunification) is come, and his wife (saints) hath made herself ready. 8. And to her was granted (to) be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for... the righteousness of saints. 9... And he (one of the heavenly hosts) saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb... 10... I fell at his feet to worship... And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God... testimony of Jesus is the spirit (the gift) of prophecy.

11. And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war (spiritual means for God working the Apocalypse of John). 12. His eyes were as a flame of fire (incinerating), and on his head were many crowns (great leadership); and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. 13. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name (calling-out) is called The Word of God (Truth). 14. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. 15. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations... rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God (post-atomic war on earth). 16. And he hath on his vesture (robe) and on his thigh (blood) a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. 17. And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God (marriage banquet of the Lamb Jesus Christ); 18. (Scavengers) may eat the flesh of kings.... flesh of captains... flesh of mighty men... flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and... flesh of all men, both free and bond... 19. And I saw the beast (Satan)... kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered... to make war against him that sat on the horse (God), and against his army. 20. And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet (like Bush, speaking for the “city set on a hill”) that wrought miracles (great wonders in human eyes) before him (respectful to – the beast), with which (with the false prophet) he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast.... These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. 21. And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which... proceeded out of his mouth (Word of God): and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Apocalypse 20: 1. And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit (endless tribulation) and a great chain in his hand. 2. And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years (for eternal life), 3. And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up (collected him), and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more (silence), till the thousand years should be fulfilled (losing oneself beyond the moment): and after that he must be loosed a little season (errors). 4. And I saw thrones (honor), and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them... beheaded (as John the Baptist) for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned (still) with Christ a thousand years (for eternal life). 5. But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished (finding oneself again the moment). This is the first resurrection. 6. Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. 7. And when the thousand years are expired (tiring of focus), Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, 8. And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters (directions) of the earth, Gog (George Bush), and Magog (George Bush) (the Axis of Evil), to gather them... to battle... of whom is as the sand of the sea (everyone). 9. And they went up on the breadth of the earth (satellite weaponry), and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city (Jerusalem – City of David – targeted): and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them. 10. And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. 11. And I saw a great white throne, and him... on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. 12. And I saw the dead... stand before God; and the (holy) books were opened: and another book was opened... the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things... written in the books, according to their works (instant returns). 13. And the sea gave up the dead... in it; and Death and Hades delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14... Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. (It’s the Judgment Day, so hell or heaven.)

Apocalypse 21: 1.... I saw a new heaven and a new earth (complete transformation of humanity’s conscious reality): for the first heaven (concept of mind) and the first earth (concept of matter) were passed away; and there was no more sea. (John is talking about earth/heaven, not earth/sea.) 2. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven (landing on the next planet of transmigration), prepared as a

bride (saint) adorned for her husband (God). 3... Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them.... 4.... God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. 5.... Behold, I make all things new.... 6... I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely (like Jesus with the Samaritan woman at the well). 7. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. (You'll be the Messiah, God's one self.) 8. But the fearful, and unbelieving, and abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars (seditious), shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. (How can you do such things and realize cosmic unity?) 9. And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife. 10. And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me... the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven... (living new life in God's unity), 11. (the city) Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a (clear) stone most precious (vision); 12. And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written... the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel (representing all legitimate world religions)... 13. On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates. 16. And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the (golden) reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal. 17. And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four (12x12) cubits, according to the measure of a man... of the angel. 18.... the wall of it was of jasper (clear): and the city was pure gold, like unto clear glass (as astronauts' visors – thinly gold-plated). 19... the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones... (You might decipher these birthstones for yourselves.) 21. And the twelve gates were twelve pearls (true paths to God): every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass (as astronauts' visors also). 22... the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it... the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof (no sun or moon). 24. And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it. 25. And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there. 26. And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it. 27. And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.

Apocalypse 22 (This describes God's utopia to John.): 1. And he shewed me a pure river of water (spirit) of life (eternal), clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. 2... on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits (one for each month): and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. 3. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: 4. And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads. 5. And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever. 7.... blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book. 8... I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things. 9. Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets... 10... Seal not (Keep open) the sayings of the prophecy of this book (Let people know): for the time is at hand. 11. He that is unjust, let him be unjust still (real self)... filthy... filthy still... righteous... righteous still... holy... holy still. 12... behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work (karma) shall be. 13. I am Alpha and Omega... beginning and the end... 14. Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter (new Jerusalem). 15. For without are (the seditious). 16. I Jesus... am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star (Lucifer). 17... the Spirit and the bride say, Come... let him that heareth say, Come. 18. For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book... If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: 19. And if any man shall take away from the words of the book... God shall take away his part out of the book of life.... 21. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.
