assumptions (EX 146)	Values in cells that you can change to determine new values for formulas.	I don't normally use this.
Office Clipboard (EX 157)	Special place in the computers memory that allows you to collect text and graphic items	I sometimes use this
drag and drop (EX 159)	Using the mouse to move or copy cells.	I always use this.
#REF! (EX 162)	Excel displays the error message in cells to indicate a cell reference error.	I don't know what this is.
freeze the titles (EX 163)	Excel displays the titles on the screen, no matter how far down to the right you scroll.	I have used this a couple times
date stamp (EX 165)	Shows the date a workbook, report, or other document was created or the period it represents.	I don't know what this is.
NOW function (EX 165)	One of the 14 date and time functions available in Excel.	I use this sometimes
absolute cell reference (EX 168)	\$B\$20- Instructs Excel to keep the cell reference B20 constant in the formula as it copies it to the destination area.	I have used this.

mixed cell reference (EX 168)	A cell reference with only one dollar sign before either the column or the row	I have used this a little.
relative cell reference (EX 168)	Instructs Excel to adjust the cell reference as it copies it to the destination area.	I know how to do this.
IF function (EX 171)	Useful when you want to assign a value to a cell based on a logical test.	I use this sometimes.
nested IF function (EX 176)	The action to be taken for the true or false case includes yet another IF function.	I don't really use this.
Drawing toolbar (EX 181)	Provides tools that can simplify adding lines, boxes, and other geometric figures to a worksheet.	I don't normally use this.
floating toolbar (EX 182)	Displayed in its own window and can be moved anywhere in the Excel window.	I know what this is.
toolbar dock (EX 182)	If you drag the toolbar close to the edge of the window, Excel positions the toolbar here.	I do this sometimes.
category names (EX 187)	The month names in a range that will identify the slices of the Pie chart	I don't use this.
chart sheet (EX 187)	A separate sheet which contains only a chart.	I sometimes use this on a project..
data series (EX 187)	Range that contains data that determines the size of the slices in the pie.	I have seen this sometimes.
exploded Pie chart (EX 187)	A Pie chart with one or more slices offset.	I don't see this often.
Pie chart (EX 187)	Used to show the relationship or proportion of parts to whole.	I use this.
offsetting (EX 194)	Exploding	I don't know what this is.
horizontal split bar (EX 204)	Going across the middle of the window.	I don't use this.
sensitivity analysis (EX 204)	Using Excel to scrutinize the impact of changing	I don't know what this is.

vertical split bar (EX 204)	Bar going up and down middle of the window.	I don't use this.
what-if analysis (EX 204)	Using Excel to scrutinize the impact of changing values in cells that are referenced by a formula in another cell.	I have sometimes used this.
goal seeking (EX 206)	Determines the value of a cell on which the formula depends.	I don't use this.
