Rajiv Malhotra is the foremost Hindu American intellectual aspects when it comes to matters of strategic thinking on Hinduism and Indic issues. He gave up a very highly successful entrepreneurial career to dedicate all his wealth and his life for the betterment of Hindu society worldwide and for better understanding between cultures, especially India and the West. To undertake this mission, he established the Infinity Foundation in 1995. Rajiv Malhotra has written extensively and spoken at many prestigious international conferences and venues on issues facing Indian civilization today, and has engaged with leaders from Academia, Industry and Government in these discussions.

His accomplishments include:

1. The western world has realized the power of harnessing the academic institutes' enormous influence on public thought, in addition to their clergy's influence on lay people. Our Hindu religion has (to date) not realized the power academic institutes have over religious thought, and has rarely invested in anything but Temples. Besides courageously debating and rigorously critiquing abusive scholarship on Hinduism, Rajiv and the Infinity Foundation have given over 250 grants to Universities and individual scholars to help further objective and balanced research on India and Hinduism. This has led to more authentic research and teaching of subjects like Hindu Philosophy at prestigious US Universities.
2. An important example is Infinity's leading role in collaboration with various top class Indian scholars to create an important academic discipline called Indian Psychology- based on Yoga and other Indic theories about the Mind. This collaboration that has led to a multi-volume textbook series as well as the establishment of a prestigious conference series, putting Indian Psychology on the Academic Map, on par with Western Psychology.
3. Sponsored and Lead a ground-breaking Collaboration of some of the best Indian Scientists and Technologists in creating a 20 Volume series on the History of India's Science and Technology. This series will change the world's opinion on the contributions by Ancient Indians in the areas of metallurgy, irrigation, astronomy, mathematics, yoga and martial arts, forestry and ecology, textile technology, etc. This will lead to the establishment of an Academic discipline dedicated to research and teaching of this area.
