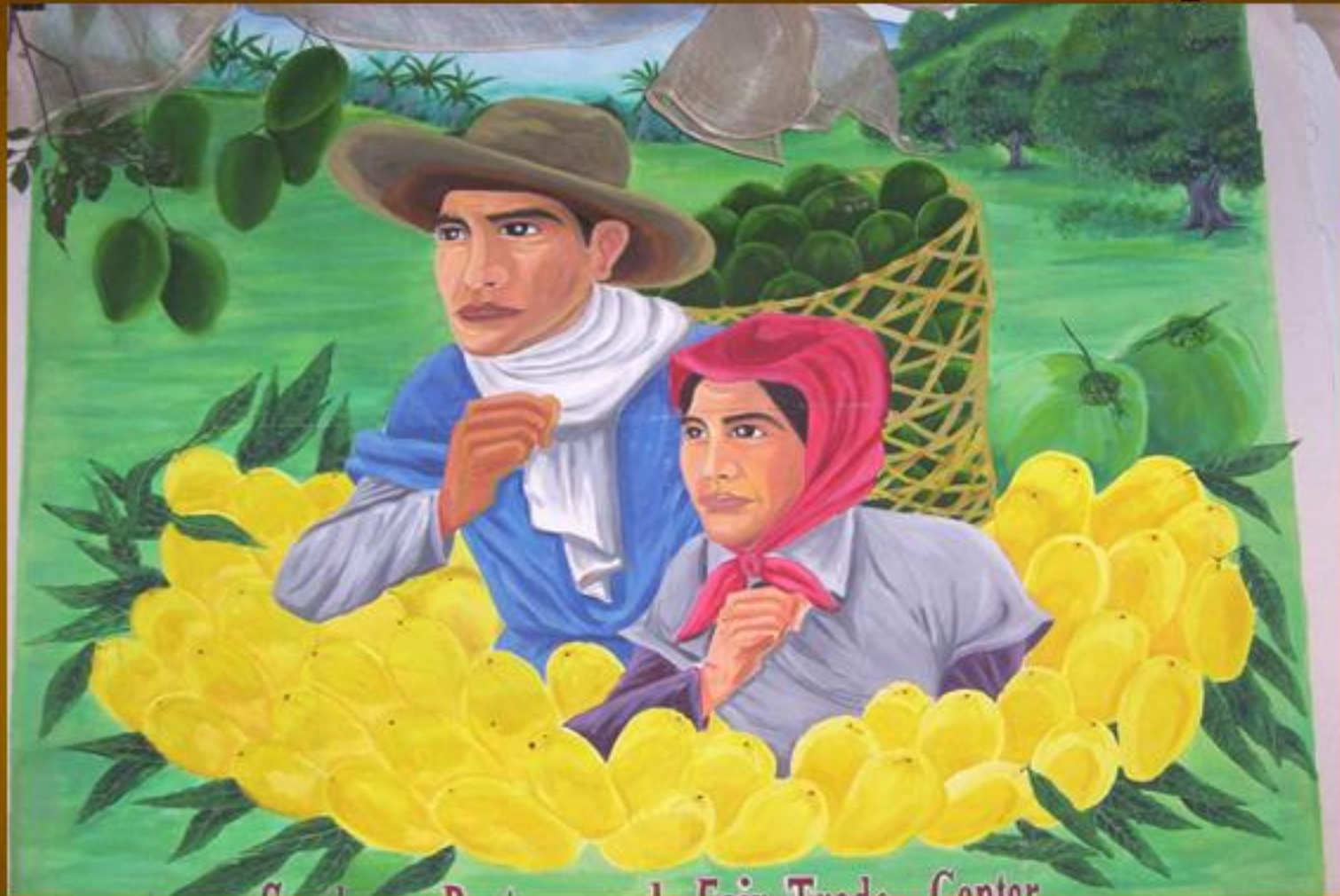

BAHI Association- was conceived in the late 1990 when land conversion in Talisay town was at its peak. Because of rapid urban development, thousands of families that rely mainly on farming and fishing for livelihood have been severely affected and displaced. The result was economic dislocation in the guise of development. To respond to this scenario, home-based enterprises were developed to cater to dislocated families. At this period the important role of women in home-based enterprise was recognized. Hence, an association of women was organized and established.
