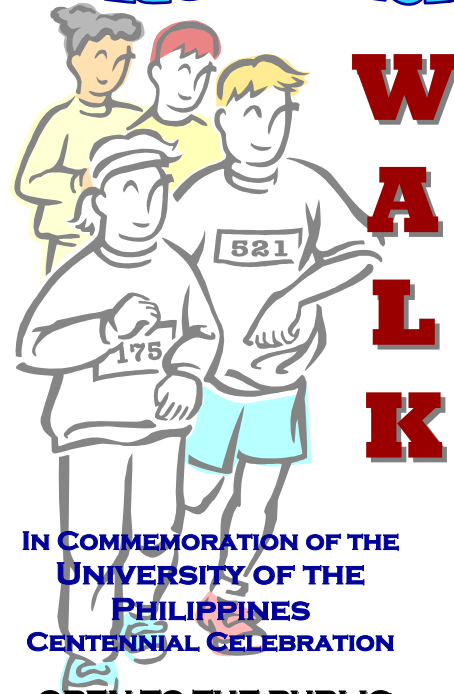

CENTENNIAL WALK
