

DEFINITION OF WORDS RELATED TO RAPE

- 1.) Abuse- putting violence on someone.
- 2.) Acquaintance rape- when the victim knows the rapist.
- 3.) Aggressor- someone who attacks someone, in this case the rapist.
- 4.) Consent- giving permission.
- 5.) Date rape- rape committed to the victim when the victim has gone on a date with the aggressor.
- 6.) Domestic violence- violence in the home, generally involves violent abuse against partner or spouse.
- 7.) Ketamine- a drug commonly used in date rapes. It may paralyse muscles and can cause strong hallucinations as a side effect.
- 8.) Marital rape- When the rapist commits rape against there spouse or partner.
- 9.) Rape- sexual penetration or sexual intercourse from aggressor to victim without consent.
- 10.) Rape culture- a society where rape is excused or normalized.
- 11.) Rapist- someone who has committed rape.
- 12.) Perpetuator- someone who keeps something going, in this case someone who helps keep rape culture going.
- 13.) Rohypnol- a potent sedative drug, many times the rapist may drug the victim with.
- 14.) Prosecutor- the lawyer against a defendant in court.

- 15.) Sex- sexual intercourse with consent. Rape and sex are not the same.
- 16.) Sexual assault- unwanted sexual contact.
- 17.) Sexual harassment- unwelcome sexual advances, and requests for sexual behaviors, and harassment of a sexual behavior.
- 18.) Victim- Someone who has been harmed in some way, in this case the person who has been raped.
- 19.) Victim blame- placing the blame on the victim.
- 20.) Violation- not respecting someone or something.
