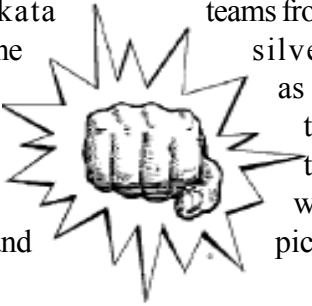
Canmore Summer Camp Aug 2 - 4:

 This is a weapons class. This is a different style from Chito Ryu and has separate costs. Chito Ryu members pay \$15.00 month + annual fees, others pay \$30.00/month + annual fees

Fees for 2002

- Regular Teen/Adult Fee:** (covers any/all karate classes) \$40.00/monthly or \$110/quarter or \$360.00/year + annual fees of \$45.00 (\$85.00 for black belts)
- Sunday Class Only Fee:** \$60.00/10 classes + annual fees of \$45.00
- Children's Fee:** (Junior Class) \$75.00/ session or \$30.00/month plus annual fees of \$45.00
- Saturday Class Only Fee:** \$40.00/10 classes + annual fees of \$45.00
- Family Fee:** (Parents & children for any/all classes) \$200.00/quarter + annual fees
- Grading Fee:** Adults - \$20.00*
 Juniors - \$10.00*

*Paid only once for each belt level
