

Extra Credit

Students may earn a **maximum** of:

50 extra credit points for the 1st 6 week grading period

75 extra credit points for the 2nd 6 week grading period

100 extra credit points for the 3rd 6 week grading period

Extra credit may be turned in at **ANY** time during class.

Extra credit is “due” at the beginning of the period on **TUESDAY** before the end of the grading period.

Note: No extra credit will be accepted during Finals Week.

Brose Bucks will be turned in the **THURSDAY** before the end of the grading period.

Note: Brose Bucks will be turned in the Thursday before Finals Week.

There are a number of ways students may earn extra credit.

Some ways to earn extra credit:

- Math Team Tests: Given monthly at lunch in my classroom. They consist of six questions, 10 points for each correct answer.
- Make a Math Poster (limit one per 6 weeks): Look at the posters in my room for examples. Posters are awarded up to 25 points each.
- Make a Power Point Presentation (limit one per 6 weeks): An “average” Power Point Presentation will be awarded 50 points. Students should pick a topic that would help themselves (and other students) understand a topic better. Please turn in a hard copy (print out) as well as the file (on disc).
- Watch a “math” video (limit one per 6 weeks): Students may watch a “math” video and **type** a single-spaced one page response (**Not** a summary). These videos include: bridge building, string theory, Archimedes, etc. Videos may be checked out from Mr. Brose and must be returned the next school day (subject to availability). Write-Ups are awarded up to 25 points.
- Tape and watch a “math” video (limit one per 6 weeks): Same as “watch a math video” except student will tape “math” show. Student will turn in video (or DVD) **and** written response. Student will receive 50 points. Please check with Mr. Brose prior to taping show.
- Bring me the bar code from the box of any Texas Instruments **graphing** calculator and receive 25 points. (I mail these to T.I. and they give me cool, free stuff!)
