Entry fee: \$4.00 per class Office fee: \$2.00 per horse.

Entries must be made no later than 3 classes prior to start. **NO REFUNDS!**

Must be three entries in class or may be combined.

Note: Only one animal per exhibitor per class-no exceptions.

There are separate judges for Trail and Dressage classes that will run concurrent with other classes.

Points for county teams will be given as follows: First place – 6 points; Second place – 5 points; Third place – 4 points; Fourth place – 3 points; Fifth place – 2 points; Sixth place – 1 point.

4-Hers must show for the county in which they are enrolled.

Walk trot exhibitors may show in walk-trot classes, halter, and showmanship classes only.

The winning team will win \$250 gift towards an educational speaker for their show participants.
