Bounded on the East by the Parish of Glenmuick; on the North by the Parliamentary Parish of Tomintoul; on the West by the parliamentary road to Corgarff; and on the South by the River Dee – the population, with the exception of twin(?) Houses at the head of the river Gartly, is exclusively confined to the vale of the Dee – the rest of the district is, mostly, covered with heath – the surface is very irregular.
