Standard Guidelines

Part I: Requirements for New Representatives

1. Must be an official member (either by baptism or transfer) of the Pilipino Community Church (P.C.C.).
2. Must consistently attend Sunday service. Must support church activities/ministries.
3. Must be musically inclined and must have a teachable heart. Set timetable for new members. Probation will be set by the instructor under his own discretion.

Part II: Guidelines for New Representatives

1. New representatives who volunteer are always welcome based on their dedication and availability
2. Any potential representatives will be recommended to the group leader to schedule an appointment for an informal interview. Such new representative will then be presented to the Magnification Team leader/s and the Senior Pastor.
3. The new representatives will undergo an orientation for 3 months. They will be introduced and exposed to different functions and jobs in the ministry by their appropriate group leader/s.
4. The new representatives will undergo a trial period for one year. The new representatives will be asked for their commitment every quarter by their appropriate group leader/s.
This commitment includes:
 - a) Attending and participating scheduled practices.
 - b) Supporting and attending seminars and workshops within and outside the church
 - c) “Reaching out” ministries (i.e. Birthdays, funerals, convalescent homes, etc.)

Part III: Responsibilities of Active Representatives

Our Father is always seeking for the worshipers who worship in Spirit and in truth.

1. Worship Him with all your heart and not half-heartedly.
2. Preparation of your heart and mind (i.e. Prayer, focusing, attitude, meditating).
3. Preparation of your body (i.e. Proper attire, personal hygiene, proper body movement, etc.)
4. Preparation of your vocal/instrumental parts at all times.
5. Responsibility to know future schedules and plans.
6. Responsibility to attend consistently with the schedules and plans that is set by the leaders.

Note: *Inconsistent attendance will hinder proper preparations, which will weaken the body.*

7. Accountability to be on time for the schedule assigned.
8. Responsibility and caring for the instruments and other tools used in the ministry.

Note: *This includes the preparation of copies of the songs and filing them back with the transparency sheets after use.*

This ministry is a team effort. Each is a part of this body. Know that part and do it well.

9. Support this ministry with all your might, talent, with boldness and humility.

Part IV: Guidelines for Inactive Representatives

Part II-4 Guideline is applied for the representatives who, for any reason, expressed his or her inactiveness to represent in this ministry. A status change from “inactive” to “active” representative is with the approval of the Senior Pastor/Youth Pastor.

Part V: Guidelines for Honorary Representative

Honorary Representatives are “Guests” of P.C.C. They do not attend our church regularly.

1. A background check must be satisfied by the Senior Pastor/Youth Pastor of P.C.C. and/or the ministry leader.
2. Part I-3 is applied.

Part VI: Guidelines from the other ministry, individual or group:

1. Any request to support any activity/event in the musical aspect must accomplish strictly the following requirements:
 - a. Type of activity/event
 - b. Date and time of activity/event
 - c. Place of activity/event
 - d. Plot of activity/event
2. A copy of this requirement must be submitted as early as possible to the Magnification Ministry Leader/s for evaluation. It is the responsibility of the Ministry Leader/s to verify with and/or inform the PCC office.
3. Any music ministry representative will not entertain any verbal request made by any ministry, individual or group.
