Philippine Consulate General Joins "Hawaii Seniors' Fair, The Good Life Expo," 19 – 21 September 2008

The Philippine Consulate General in Honolulu, in coordination with the Philippine Retirement Authority (PRA), participated in the 24th annual "Hawaii Seniors' Fair, The Good Life Expo," held at Neal S. Blaisdell Concert Hall from 19 – 21 September 2008. The special event saw the attendance of thousands of senior citizens.

The three (3) whole day Fair was Hawaii's annual largest showcase of products, services and programs for senior citizens and their families. The primary focus of the fair was on health, wellness, personal fitness, legal, financial, travel and leisure, lifestyle products, community service and volunteer opportunities. There were over 300 participating booths from various health providers, health institutions, non-profit organizations, caregiver associations along with state agencies that took part in the Fair, which was open to the public and admission was free.

The Philippine Consulate set-up an information booth to promote retirement programs which the Philippines can offer to senior citizens. The Consulate also disseminated tourism promotional materials and provided replies to questions on consular services.
