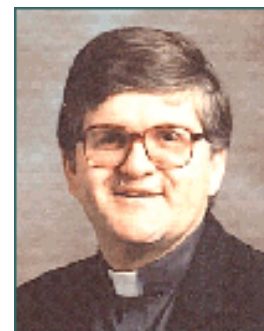

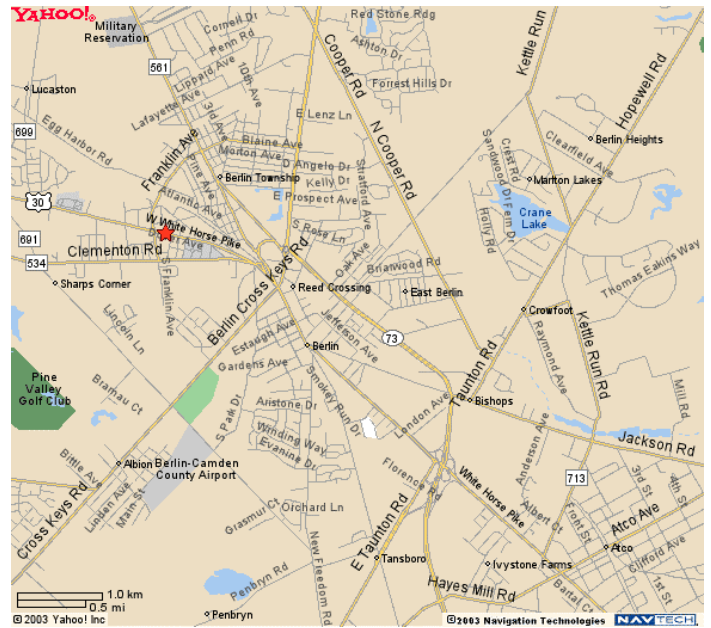

Berlin, New Jersey (NJ) is near the intersections of United States (US) Highway 30 (White Horse Pike in NJ), NJ Highway 73, and Camden County (CC) Highways 689, 561, 536, and 534. US 30 runs through Philadelphia, crosses the Benjamin Franklin Bridge, and heads east through Berlin to Atlantic City.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel (OLMC) Church is at the corner US 30 and Franklin Avenue which connects between CC 534 and NJ 73. Franklin Avenue crosses US 30 at OLMC and CC 561 a few blocks to the north. The OLMC parking lot may be accessed from Maple Avenue and North Cedar Avenue as well as US 30. OLMC is shown as a star (red, if you have color,) on these maps.
