His knowledge of the scriptures and his preaching has made Father Bill a popular conference speaker throughout the world. He is a Bible teacher for both adults and children. He has preached at Youth Conferences at Steubenville. A man alive with the Holy Spirit, he wants nothing less than for every person to be renewed in the Holy Spirit! Father Bill has served with Hispanic Ministries. He has been a retreat master and preached at conferences as well as days of recollection in many countries. He is a member of the Fraternity of Priests. He loves to celebrate Holy Mass with dynamic preaching followed by Healing Services.

Williamstown, New Jersey (NJ) is near the intersections of United States (US) Highway 322, NJ 42 (Black Horse Pike), Gloucester County (GC) Highways (GCH) 536 Spur (Williamstown Road), 633 (Blue Bell Road), and 654 (Main Street). US 322 runs through Chester, PA crosses the Commodore Barry Bridge, and heads Northeast through Glassboro, Williamstown, and then on to Atlantic City, NJ. It has interchanges with Interstate (I) – 295 (Exit 11A) and NJ Turnpike (NJTPK) (Exit 2).

From the North, exit NJTPK at Exit 4, go Northwest on NJ 73 to I-295 South, follow I-295 South to merge onto NJ 42 (Black Horse Pike). From the West follow NJ-42 (Black Horse Pike) until it merges with US 322 then about 6 blocks to Walnut Street (just past a Cooper Tire with a Liquor Store on the corner). Turn right on Walnut Street, go one block and cross Main Street (GCH 654) into Saint Mary's Church parking lot.

From the South, exit NJTPK at Exit 2, or I-295 at Exit 11A, go east on US 322 toward Glassboro and Williamstown. At the traffic signal with Main Street (GCH 654) and GCH 536 Spur (Williamstown Road) where US 322 goes left to join NJ 42 (Black Horse Pike). Turn onto Main Street (GCH 654). Follow Main





Street (GCH 654) past the Fire Station and Carrol Avenue turn right into the Saint Mary's Church parking lot.

From the East or West you may use the Atlantic City Expressway (ACE) to the Williamstown (GCH 536 Spur) Exit 38. Go South toward Williamstown, and follow either the North or South directions above from the junction or merge with US 322.

Saint Mary's Church, the star (red, if you have color,) is at the Southeast corner Main Street (GCH 654) and Carrol Avenue. The Church parking lot is accessed from Main Street (GCH 654) with an exit to Carrol Avenue.

Please come early for **Holy Mass** at 7 *PM* and ask friends to come with you. Car- or van- pooling will help those who have trouble driving at night to get home after the **Healing Service**.

Plan to be at *Saint Mary's* Church until about *10 PM*.
