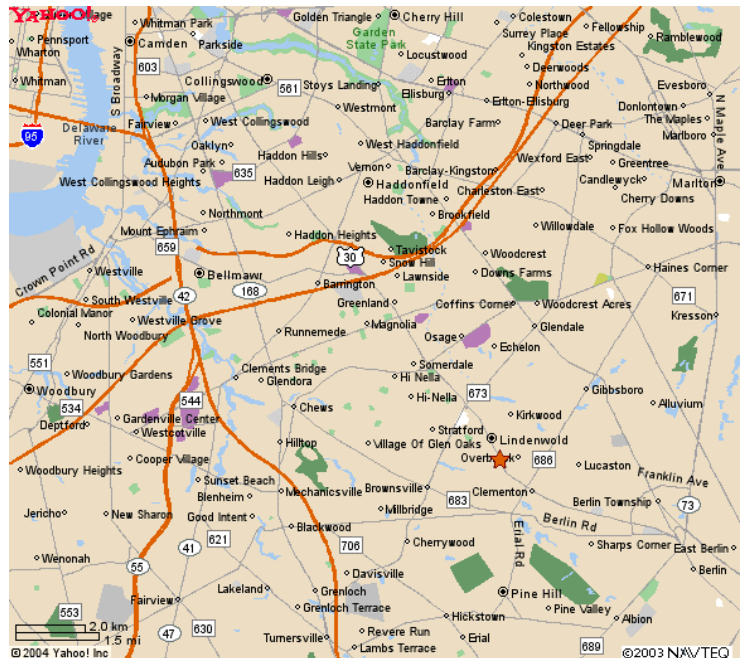
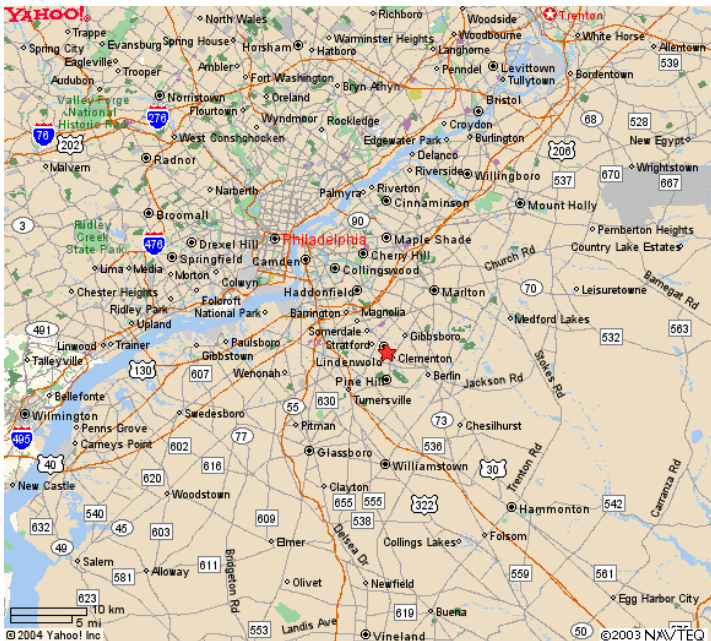

His fluency in both Italian and Spanish, as well as his knowledge of the scriptures and his practice of healing ministry have made Father Giovanni a popular celebrant for Holy Mass in the Brooklyn Diocese.

A man alive with the Holy Spirit, he wants nothing less than for every person to be renewed in the Holy Spirit! He has preached at conferences and days of recollection. He has been a retreat master. He loves to celebrate Holy Mass followed by Healing Services.

Lindenwold, New Jersey (NJ) is near the intersections of **United States (US) Highway 30 (White Horse Pike** in NJ), with **Camden County (CC) Highways (CCH) 673 (White Horse / Laurel Rd.)**, **686 (Gibbsboro Rd.)**, **669 (Stone Rd.)**, and **697 (Chestnut Ave.)** **US 30** runs through **Philadelphia**, crosses the **Benjamin Franklin Bridge**, and heads east through **Lindenwold** to **Atlantic City**. It has an interchange with **Interstate (I) – 295** but not with the **NJ Turnpike (NJTPK)**.

From the **North**, exit **NJTPK** at **Exit 4**, go northwest on **NJ 73** to **I-295 South**, follow **I-295 South** to the exit for **US 30 East** toward **Lawnside, Lindenwold, and Berlin**. Follow **US 30 East** to **Saint Lawrence Church**.

From the **South**, exit **NJTPK** at **Exit 3**, go southeast on **NJ 168** toward **Blackwood** to **CCH 544**. Turn left at **Saint Teresa of the Infant Jesus Church** in **Runnemede, NJ**, and follow **CCH 544 (Evesham Road)** to **US 30**, turn right at **Saint Gregory Church** in **Magnolia, NJ** and proceed east to **Saint Lawrence Church**.



Saint Lawrence Church is at the northeast corner **US 30** and **South Avenue**. There is a traffic signal at the intersection of **US 30** and **South Avenue**.

The **Saint Lawrence Church** parking lot may be accessed from **South Avenue** with an exit onto **US 30**.

The star (red, if you have color,) on these maps is one long block east of the church.

Please come early for **Holy Mass** at **7 PM** and ask friends to come with you.

Car- or van- pooling will help those who have trouble driving at night to get home after the **Healing Service**.

Plan to be at **Saint Lawrence Church** until about **10 PM**.
