Monday, 22 March 2004, will be hosted by Dom Lettieri and the team from In His Sign (IHS) Ministries.

Tuesday, 23 March 2004, will be hosted by Kathleen Werner and the team from the PFMC.

The evenings will last from about **5:30 PM** until about **10 PM** with prayer, praise, and worship including 10-20 decades of the Rosary starting at **6 PM**, Holy Mass (except Allentown) about **7 PM**, and the evening will close with an interpreted talk by **Ivan Dragicevic**.

A free-will or love offering for **Ivan** is to be collected during the Offertory of Holy Mass.

Daily, about **6:40 PM**, no matter where he is in the world or in what time zone, **Ivan** is stopped in his prayer and blessed with an apparition of the *GOSPA, Our Lady, Mary, the Blessed Virgin Mother of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ*. Dom Lettieri (IHS) and Kathleen Werner (PFMC) have determined that a ticket system must be utilized to assist with making sure that limited seating is not overwhelmed. *IHS* and *PFMC* are asking a **\$10**

donation for each seat reservation or admission (open seating) ticket. Children, handicapped, deacons, priests, and religious will be admitted without charge but should have a ticket to account for the seating limitations.

Please send a **STAMPED, SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE** to the ministries involved for the specific night or nights you wish to be present to hear **Ivan** speak about his experiences with and messages from the **GOSPA**.

IHS and **PFMC** must have a name for each ticket to be issued. Please send in your name, address, and phone number, or list of names, addresses, and phone numbers, and a **STAMPED SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE** as soon as possible so **IHS** and **PFMC** have time to return your ticket(s) to you by regular mail.

Priests should indicate their desire to concelebrate Holy Mass (except at the Allentown location). Deacons should indicate their desire to assist with either Holy Mass or the services provided. Handicapped should indicate if they will use wheel chairs or other medical apparatus that will not fit in normal seating. This is for special seating or places.

No one should come to the listed locations expecting to gain entry without pre-arrangements for admission (Allentown, PA) or a ticket (Drexel Hill, PA and Berlin, NJ).

Call each ministry up to NOON on the day of each visit, if you have not received your tickets. There may be some admission seat reservations / tickets reserved for pick-up at the door of each facility.
